Debate on Europe - education of participants and presentation of concrete achievements of the EU achieved in the 65 years of the it's existence, discussion of the future of the EU, increasing European awareness among participants

Roma minority and its culture - workshop and presentation of the culture of the Roma national minority, enriching the palette of cultural wealth of the partnership with other cultural elements, erasing prejudices against Roma.

The competition in cooking traditional national dishes and the Fair of traditions - served to overcome national barriers, support communication and mutual presentation of the specifics of different nations

How to become an active citizen - presentation of volunteer organizations from partner cities, debate on active involvement of citizens, sowing the idea of the need for active participation in your community

National minorities in Europe - seminar on the life of national minorities in European countries

Young people and the EU - young people's discussion about education and culture in the EU, breaking down the Euroscepticism of young people towards the EU
